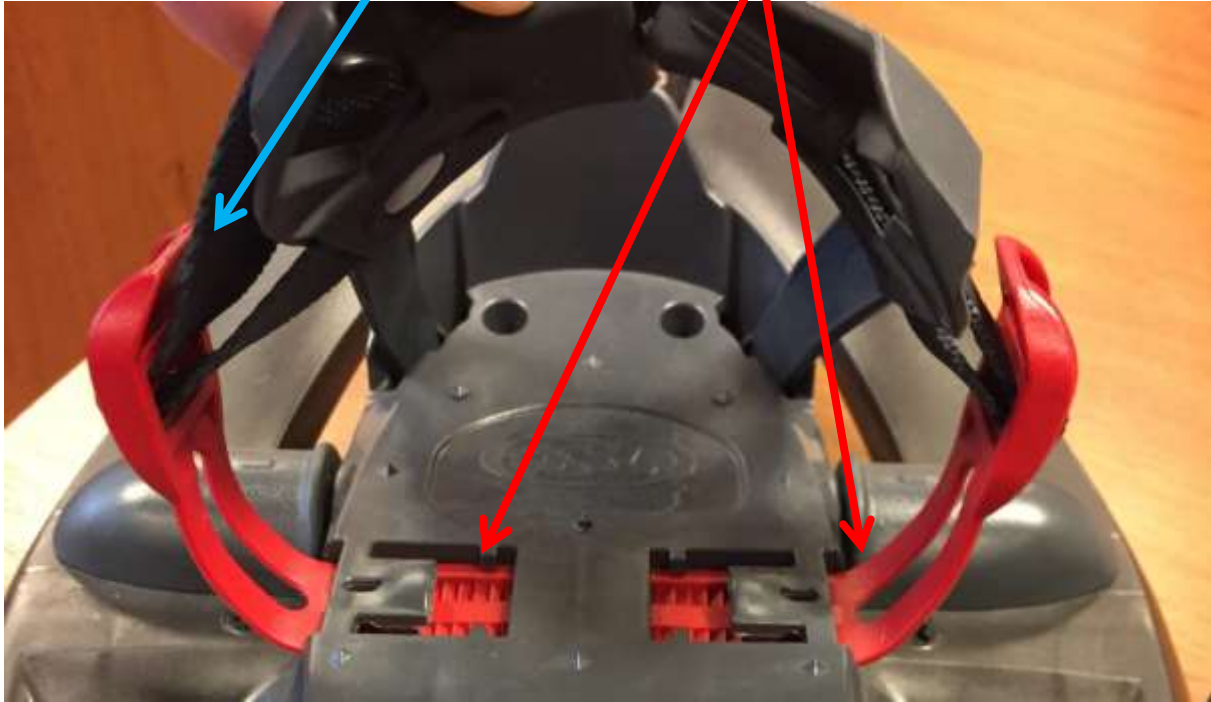


Adjustment of binding with big shoes (Pictures with 47 snowboard boot)

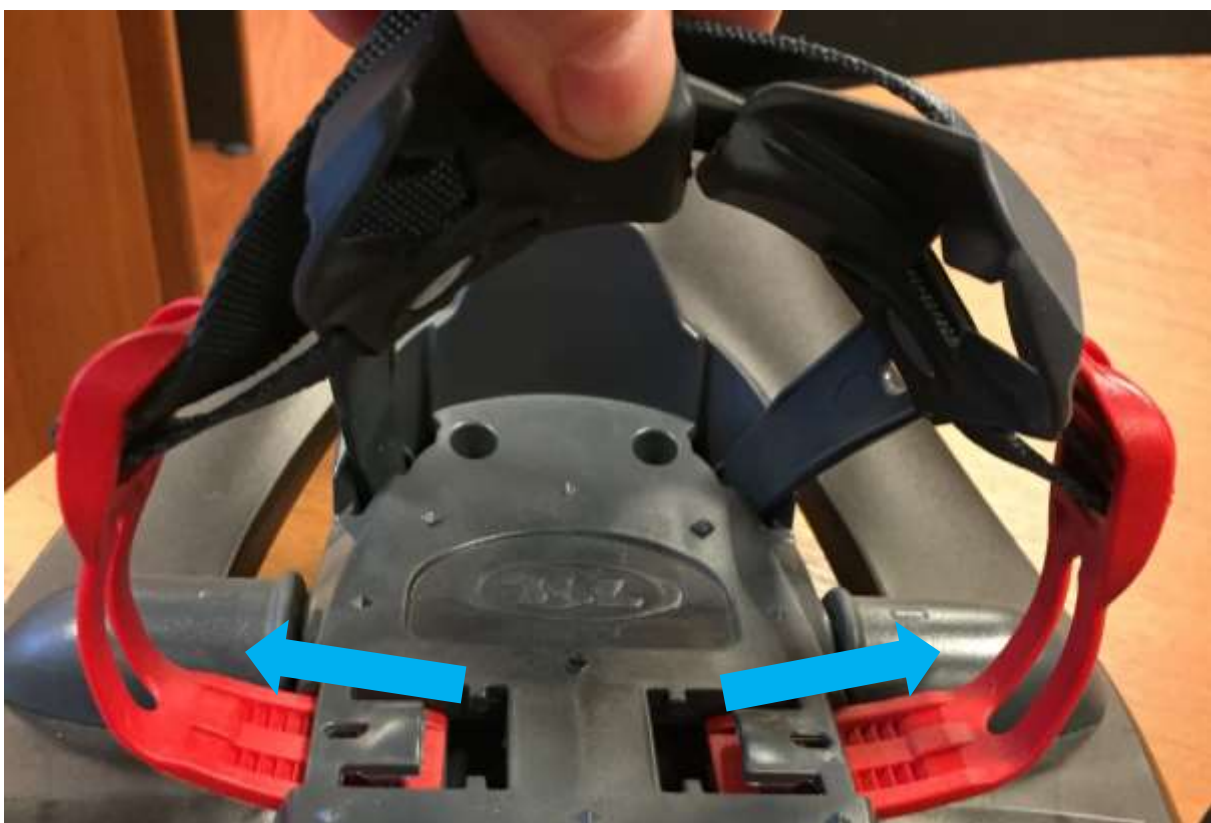
The TSL bindings have the advantage to have a full memory system. It means that before using the snowshoes, make a pre adjustment of the width, the length and the volume of the shoe for using the TSL snowshoes. Then, like all these adjustments are in memory, the memory system allows to put on the snowshoes by closing the front and the rear buckles.

For the front volume :

On the new snowshoes, the straps are pulled and the lateral adjustable winglets are closed. The front volume is small.



For accepting larger shoes, enlarge the volume by spreading the adjustable winglets.



For increasing the volume, slide the straps in the buckles.



The front volume is now ready to accept the biggest shoes of the market !



Pull the straps to close the front of the binding, with the **upper memory buckle closed**. It will be opened to introduce the shoe in the front cavity when it will be used. Push laterally the adjustable winglets to adjust the volume to the width of the shoes (if necessary).



For the length :

For adjusting the length of the binding to the length of the shoe, push on **the side buttons** and pull or push the **heel cup** to adjust it at the size of the shoe. The **numbers** give the length of the shoe in centimeters (TSL delivers carpets and measurer stickers for rental shops).



For the rear volume :

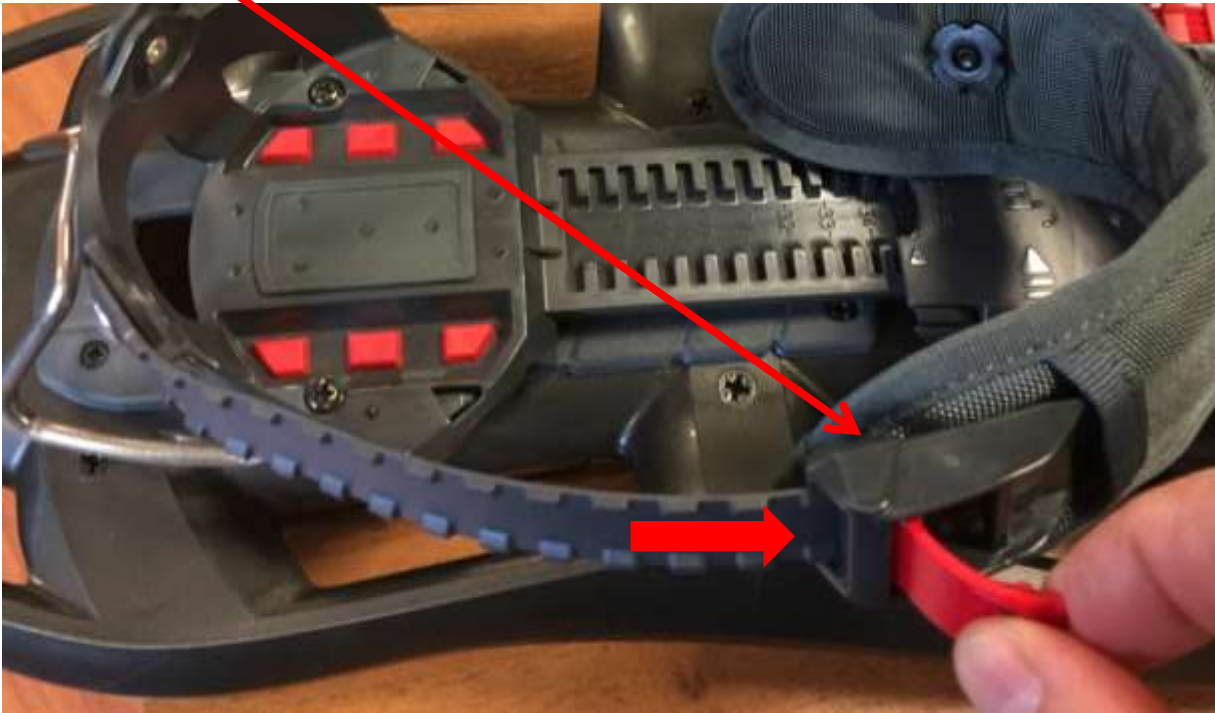
The factory pre adjustments do not allowed the big shoes.



Indeed, the **memo lever** is adjusted at the middle of the memo rear rack.



Open the **memo lever** and move it to the required length. Close the memo lever.



Now, the rear volume is ready to accept the largest shoes.
